Booster Fees for 2015-2016 School Year

Fees:

Booster Fee: \$300 per year. This is for all students in grades: 9-12. This covers most costs associated with Marching Band and Concert Band Seasons

Competition Band Fee: \$100: 10-12 Graders in addition to ALL Percussion

Grades, and ALL Color Guard 9-12 Grades.

Band Camp Fee: \$50 per student

Instrument Rental Fee: \$75-Currently however, this is under review for possible

increase

Fee Payment Procedures:

ALL fees are paid in full on Fees, Forms and Fitting Day, or F3 Day. Returning Students/Parents with Volunteer Hours from the current 2014- 2015 school year will have their Volunteer Service Credit Hours applied to their 2015-2016 school year fees.

Volunteer Service Credit:

Earned throughout the year by volunteering. For each volunteer hour served a \$2 credit can be applied toward a reduction in Booster Fees, for up to a maximum of \$100. These Service Hours will be credited at the beginning of the NEXT school year. Please note: Volunteer Credits are applied against the total balance due and are per family, not per child.

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Multi-Child Rate: 2 Student: \$250; 3 Student \$200.

Example: One Student in Marching Band: \$300 Booster Fees. \$50 Band Camp Fee. Maximum Volunteer Credit applied: \$100. Total Booster Fees Due: \$250.00 Example:

One Student in Competition Band: \$300 Booster Fees. \$100 Competition Band Fees. \$50 Band Camp Fee Maximum Volunteered Credit Applied: \$100.00 Total Booster Fees Due: \$350.00

Percussion and Color Guard Additional Fees:

Color Guard has a Choreography Fee to cover some of the Instructor costs. Color Guard will purchase uniforms and some equipment. Additional costs are associated with Winter Guard.

Percussion has an Indoor Percussion Fee due in January 2016 to cover costs associated with the Sparkman Indoor Percussion Ensemble. This fee will be announced in October. It too covers costs for Instructors, props, costumes, transportation to/from competitions etc.

The SHS Booster Fees are designed to help off-set **ALL** costs necessary to support the Band to include: Transportation (busses, Truck Rentals etc), Utilities and maintenance for Concession Percussion Instructors, Band Nurse, etc), Uniform maintenance, Instrument purchases, office Stand/Practice Field, Non-MCBOE Instructors and employees of the band (Color Guard and supplies to name a few.
