## Sparkman High School Band <br> Uniform Agreement

1. The Sparkman High School Band Marching Uniform costs:

- \$180 Jacket
- \$40 Jacket insert
- \$50 Shako
- $\$ 26$ Shako Wrap
- \$12 Shako box
- $\$ 25$ Plume
- \$36 Gauntlets
- $\mathbf{~} 20$ Garment Bags

2. Marching uniforms are provided by the SHS Band Boosters/school. Students will be assigned a uniform for use during the marching season. Care and responsibility of each assigned uniform is detailed under "Student Responsibilities".
3. The purchase of concert wear is the responsibility of the individual student. Students will purchase designated concert attire (approved by the Band Director). Care and maintenance of concert wear is the responsibility of each student.
4. Boosters will provide cleaning of all marching uniforms pieces except bibbers.

## Student Responsibilities:

1. Uniforms are numbered and assigned to each student for the year. Students are not to exchange any portion of their uniform without the knowledge of the Uniform Chair or the Band Director.
2. Uniforms are either worn or carried in a garment bag from the Sparkman High School Band Room. Uniforms will be returned to the Uniform Room after each game/competition.
3. Uniforms must be turned in before checking out from any event.
4. Uniforms WILL BE collected after the final game/competition of the year, whichever is the latest. No uniform will be accepted if it is not complete.
5. Inform the uniform committee of any repair needed prior to the next performance immediately.
6. Students will purchase a pair of marching shoes and gloves on F3 Day (if they do not have a pair from the prior year) and will wear long black socks with their uniform. Shoes should not show excessive wear and tear, should fit properly to prevent injury, and will look and present a neat and clean appearance.
7. Students will purchase a pair of black bibbers on F3 Day. These bibbers will become the property of the student and they will be responsible for washing and taking care of them.
8. Students may need to purchase compression shorts to wear under their bibbers.
9. Color Guard Liaison will advise members about care and storage of uniforms.
10. If a uniform is misused, then the student and/or parents will be held responsible for repair payment to Sparkman High School.
11. If a uniform is damaged or destroyed beyond performance use, or lost, then the student assigned that uniform will be charged for the full replacement cost of the uniform.
