
Students must have a helper take their measurements (parent or sibling is fine). A flexible measuring tape is best for accurate measurements and comfortable fit of your uniform. Do not pull the measuring tape tight.

Head – Circumference around head, just over the eyebrows **Chest** – Standing, measure while inhaling at the widest point

Waist – Standing, measure at the narrowest point or at the midway point between the top of the hip bone and the bottom of the rib cage

Wrist – Circumference, around the widest part of the wrist Hips – Measure at the largest point, approximately 9 inches below the natural waistline Inseam – distance from your inner thigh to the bottom of your ankle

Girth – Standing, top of shoulder front, between legs, up back, to same shoulder in the back

Q1: How do I take measurements of my band student?

Q3. We do not have a tailor's tape measure. What can I use as a substitute?

A taut string or dental floss can be used and measured against a yard stick to calculate your measurements in lieu of a tailor's tape.

Q4. I do not know my shoe size. Do I need to go to the shoe store to find my shoe size? Check your most comfortable pair of tennis shoes or sneakers to locate your shoe size.
